GRANTS TO NONPROFITS

- Make a gift to the community foundation of cash, appreciated stocks, real estate or other assets.
- We set up a fund in your name, in the name of your family or businessor in honor of any person or organization you choose.
- You recommend grants from the fund to your favorite nonprofit organizations.
- You may receive tax benefits in the year your gift is made.
- Our professional staff ensures the nonprofits you wish to support are in good standing.
- Our team is available to help you learn about new organizations doing good work that aligns with your interests in the community.

When David and Jayme Curley opened their donor-advised fund a few years ago, they were looking for a way to share their windfall with the community. FUND OVERVIEW DONOR ADVISED FUND

- We handle all the administrative details and issue grants to charities in the name of the fund you establish. (If you prefer, grants can be made anonymously.)
- Your gift can be placed into an endowment that is invested over time. Earnings from your fund are used to make grants addressing community needs. Your gift (and all future earnings from your gift) is a permanent source of community capital, helping to do good work forever.

OTHER ADVANTAGES

Donor advised funds offer simplified record keeping. You have one tax receipt for the gift you make to your fund in place of multiple receipts from the nonprofits you support. You can add to the fund at any time and may receive tax benefits with each new gift.

Donor advised funds are typically less costly and easier to administer than other forms of philanthropic giving (such as family or corporate foundations). You can establish a fund today and make grant recommendations now or in the future. You also have the ability to involve the next generation in recommending grants from your fund and create a legacy of family philanthropy.
