2026 Funds for Whatcom County - Health & Wellness Grants

Who can apply: Whatcom County federal nonprofits only with at least 1 FTE (no government agencies, religious institutions, fiscal sponsorships, public or private schools).

We are offering grants up to \$10,000 to address issues of nonprofit staff fatigue, turnover and burnout. We are committed to supporting a healthy, inclusive nonprofit workforce. This includes intentional efforts to strengthen equity across race, gender identity, ability, and age, and to provide supports that uplift younger and emerging nonprofit professionals. This funding is not intended for Board development or capital.

Some examples include:

- Wellness programs that encourage physical activity, social activities, healthy eating, stress management and mental health supports
- Professional development - coaching, training, skill building
- Team building - staff retreats, appreciation activities, workshops, inclusive communications and belonging
- Compensation – bonuses, increasing pay and/or benefits
- Targeted support programs designed for younger employees, early-career professionals, or other priority populations identified by your organization
- Assessments - review workload across all staff roles and identify measures to balance responsibilities, improve efficiency, and reduce burnout

Grant funding amounts could increase depending on the number of applicants and/or increase in funding pool. If your proposal includes multiple organizations, please let us know as you may be eligible for more funding.

Grant awards announced end of June 2026.
